

RESOLUTION FOR DISPOSAL OF PUBLIC PROPERTY

OF

PARK CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT #5

Whereas, Park City School District #5, Stillwater County, presently owns the property described as PARK CITY ORIGINAL TOWNSITE, S29, T2S, R23E, BLOCK 96, W21' LOT 11, LOTS 12-14, AND THE BUILDING THAT SITS THEREON (“hereinafter referred to as the “Property”);

Whereas, the Property has never been used as a school and it is unsuitable for school purposes.

And,

Whereas, Park City School District #5, Stillwater County, presently owns one bus (2011 Bluebird) that has become undesirable, unsuitable, or obsolete for school purposes. This item is determined to be unsuitable for school purposes.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Board of Trustees of Park City School District #5 intends to sell or dispose of the Property in full compliance with §20-6-604, MCA by posting it for sale on October 3, 2019.

Be it further resolved that all monies resulting from the sale of the Property shall become part of the District’s Interlocal Fund for the purpose that best meets the current needs of the District.

The Trustees of the Park City School District #5 further resolve that notices of the resolution shall be published on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2019, in the Stillwater County News.

The resolution shall become effective 14 days after publication of the notice identified above (Effective date is (October 2, 2019), unless appealed any time prior to that date to the District Court by a taxpayer in compliance with and as provided in §20-6-604, MCA.
